A Message from our CEO

I want to start my message by thanking our dedicated staff, Board members, volunteers, donors, advocates, and community partners for all the support which made it possible for Safe Berks to continue serving survivors of domestic violence and sexual assault 24/7 throughout the COVID-19 pandemic. This was a huge effort, and one made possible thanks to the teamwork of countless people who truly care about our mission.

The two years summarized in this report have been a time of significant change and growth at Safe Berks. In December 2019, we said goodbye to Mary Kay Bernosky after 15 years of dedicated service as our CEO. Our interim CEO, Angel Helm, provided support and leadership during the first half of 2020. In June of 2020, I began my new role as CEO of Safe Berks and am so proud to be leading this amazing team of dedicated advocates who truly put their heart and soul in their work, every day.

When the COVID-19 pandemic hit in March 2020, most people retreated to the safety of their homes. But home is not a safe place for everyone. For victims of domestic violence, home can be the most dangerous place of all. We knew it was even more critical that we continue our services so we could be here for those that needed us most. We carefully monitored CDC and DOH recommendations and did everything possible to protect the health of our clients and staff. Our staff are true heroes!

Volunteers delivered homecooked meals for our residents almost every evening of the pandemic. Donations of masks, gloves, hand sanitizer, and other needed supplies such as towels, sheets, pillows, diapers, and toiletries, poured in from individuals and community organizations across the county.

Despite the challenges of working through a pandemic, we continued to expand our services, create new positions necessary to meet the increased need for services, and strengthen collaborations with other community organizations to help address unique needs of our survivors.

On June 19, 2021, we gathered in person for our combined Celebration of Peace and Walk For NO MORE. It was our first opportunity to be together, in person, since the pandemic began, and it was a day filled with joy!

Thanks to the hard work of our dedicated staff and the support of the Berks County community, the future of Safe Berks is bright. Thanks to the teamwork of so many, we are building a Safe Berks!

New CEO & COO Guide Safe Berks through Global Pandemic

The year 2020 presented historic challenges and exciting internal changes to Safe Berks. Despite a global pandemic, Safe Berks continued to provide 24-hour free services to local survivors of domestic violence and sexual assault.

Safe Berks emerged from the COVID-19 quarantine, which began in March 2020, with two new leaders at the helm. Beth Garrigan was chosen to serve as the new CEO; and Mereliss Colon Ortiz was chosen to serve as the new COO, both effective June 1, 2020.

"I am so proud of Safe Berks, and I am honored to be given the opportunity to lead and represent such an amazing organization of dedicated individuals who are saving lives, every day," said Garrigan, who previously served Safe Berks as COO.

Prior to joining Safe Berks, Garrigan served the Children's Home of Reading and the Department of Human Services.

Colon Ortiz said she is grateful to be chosen to serve as COO. She has served the organization since 2006, working 14 years in the Safe House, providing shelter and services to survivors. From 2017 to 2020, she served as Director of Residential Services.

"I am passionate about providing the best service to every client, so they will remember they were listened to, and treated with kindness and respect," said Colon Ortiz. "I believe that people will always remember the way you made them feel."

Both Garrigan and Colon Ortiz stressed that the services Safe Berks provides are more crucial now than ever.

"The social distancing and family isolation required to stop the spread of COVID-19 has increased danger to people trapped at home with abusers," said Garrigan. "Home is not a safe place for everyone. We are very grateful for all the support we have received from the community during this difficult time, which has helped us tremendously in continuing to serve survivors."

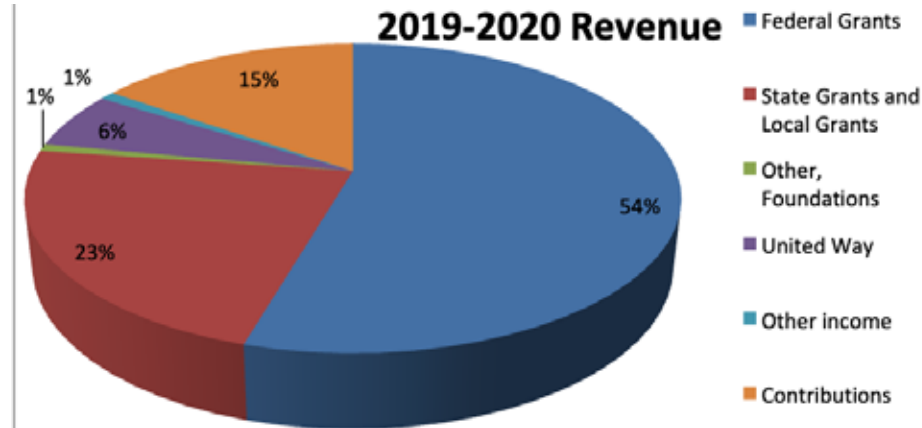

2019/2020 Operating Revenue & Expenditures

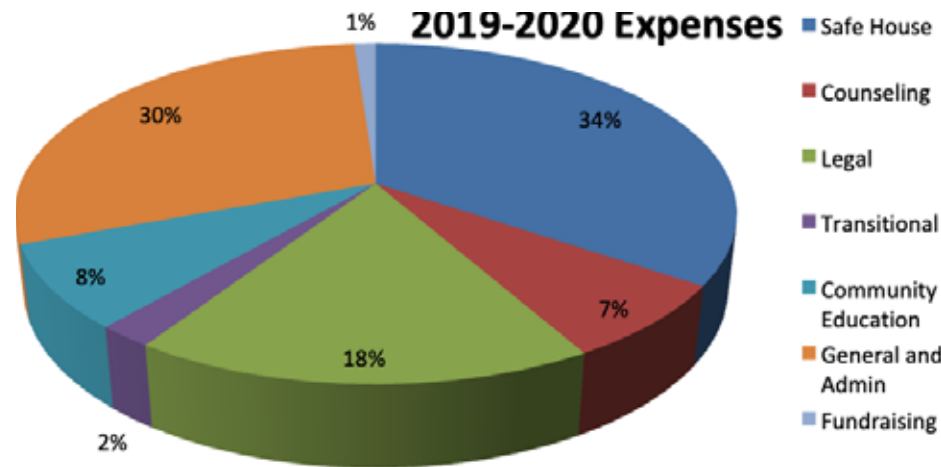

OPERATING EXPENSES

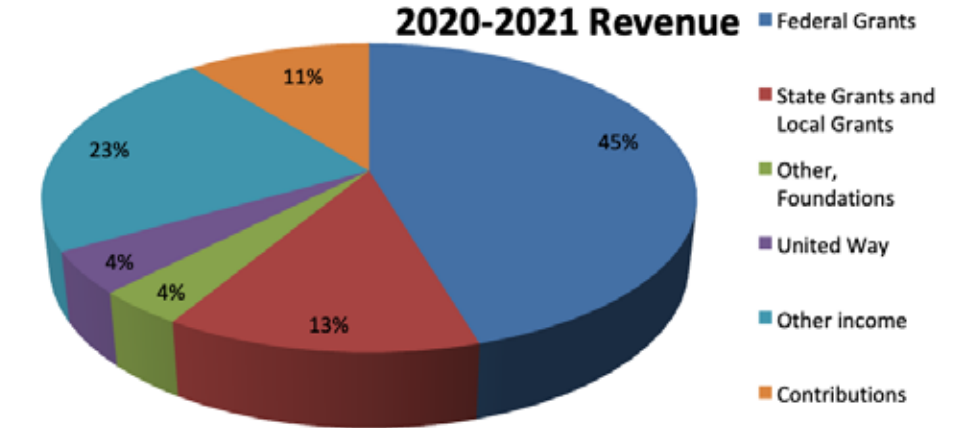

2020/2021 Operating Revenue & Expenditures

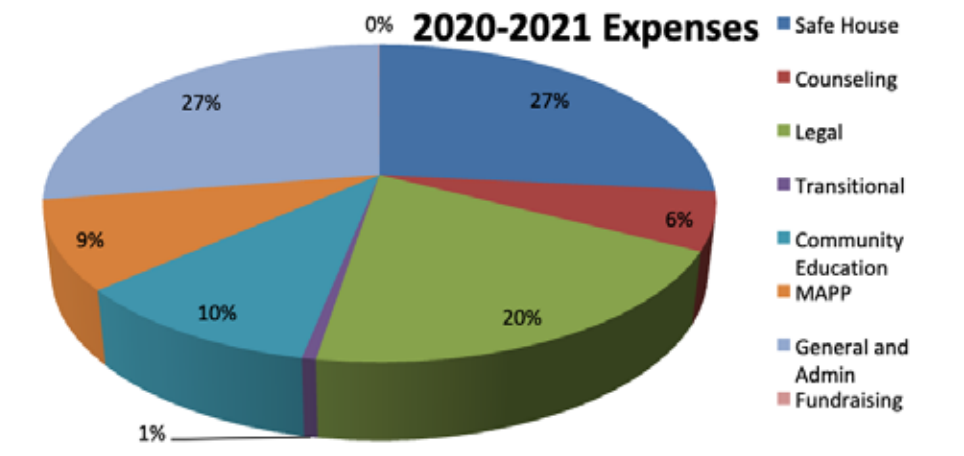

Safe Berks & District Attorney's Office Expand Partnership

Safe Berks and the Berks County District Attorney's Office joined forces to create a County-wide, multidisciplinary Sexual Assault Response Team (SART). Formation of the SART Team was approved by District Attorney John Adams in 2019. The Team had its first meeting on July 17, 2020. Due to COVID-19, meetings were held virtually, via Zoom. The purpose of a County SART is to provide a coordinated community response to victims of sexual violence, in order to minimize trauma to the victims, while promoting improved investigation into and successful prosecution of sex crimes.

The SART Team was led by Meghan Sager, Safe Berks SART Coordinator, and included: Meg McCallum, Esq., Assistant District Attorney; Molly McDonough, Esq., Assistant District Attorney; John Solecki, Berks County STOP Detective; Amy Sundstrom, Berks County Victim/Witness Unit Supervisor; Cheryl Pentheny of Reading Police Department; Eleanor Delewski, of Tower Health/Reading Hospital; and Safe Berks staff members Diane Ellis, Esq., Director of Legal Services; Jennifer Sawyer, Legal Advocate Coordinator; Macy Lluberes, Medical Advocacy Partnership Program Director; and Stacey Jordan, Campus Advocate/Paralegal.

Safe Berks Advocates Return to Night Court

Beginning Dec. 1, 2020, Safe Berks has provided advocates to victims of domestic violence who request Emergency Protection From Abuse (EPFA) orders at Night Court. Safe Berks offered this service in the past, but due to budget cuts, it was discontinued in 2017. However, it was always the goal of Safe Berks to bring back this important advocacy for survivors.

Jennifer Sawyer, Legal Advocate Coordinator, and a member of the Safe Berks Legal Department for more than 20 years, played a major role in bringing this service back. "We are grateful for the support we received from the courts to get this program up and running again," said Sawyer. "The ease of collaboration with these system partners demonstrates confidence in the services that Safe Berks provides, as well as a continued commitment to the victims we serve."



Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC)
